in january 1920, prohibition went into effect across the united states. the 18th amendment had been passed the year before--banning the manufacture, sale and transport of alcohol--at the urging of prohibition is a three-part, five-and-a-half-hour documentary film series on pbs directed by ken burns and lynn novick that tells the story of the rise, rule, and fall of the eighteenth amendment born in syracuse new york in 1877, william "bill" mccoey became known as one of the few gentlemen smugglers of the prohibition era. at 6.2 foot tall with a voice like a "fog horn", tee-total bill mccoey was a commanding figure balanced out with boyish good looks.
