What is autism spectrum disorder? autism spectrum disorder (asd) refers to a group of complex neurodevelopment disorders characterized by repetitive and characteristic patterns of behavior and difficulties with social communication and interaction. ossary acquired cerebral palsy — cerebral palsy that occurs as a result of injury to the brain after birth or during early childhood. apgar score — a numbered scoring system doctors use to assess a baby's physical state at the time of birth.
